

Knitting Eyelet lace Christmas Wreath

Materials Required :

- 7 metres of Knitting Eyelet lace in your chosen colour
- 4mm (Size 8) Knitting Needles
- Double Knitting Wool in a matching colour
- A 17cm Polystyrene Ring
- Decorations as required.

Method:

- Cast on 80 stitches, leaving enough wool to join ends together later.
- Knit 3 rows garter stitch
- Knit 1 row of lace
- Knit 5 rows
- Repeat last 2 rows until 5 rows lace complete
- Knit 1 row lace
- Knit 2 rows and cast off, leaving enough wool at cast off to sew around the ring.
- Join the ends together
- Insert the Styrofoam ring and sew all around
- Decorate as required.



The pattern may be altered to use with larger rings. Measure the circumference of the ring (17cm ring has a circumference of 53.4cm) and increase the number of stitches and amount of lace accordingly, remembering that the thickness of the ring may require additional rows too.

The projects shown used the green and gold knitting eyelet lace and the red green white tartan knitting eyelet lace, with white and green double knitting wool.

WT635DGREENGOLD - Green and Gold Knitting eyelet lace

WT-635WREDGREEN - White Red Green Knitting Eyelet lace

ROBIN045 - Robin Knitting Wool Dark Green 100gram ball

ROBIN040 - Robin Knitting Wool White 100gram ball
